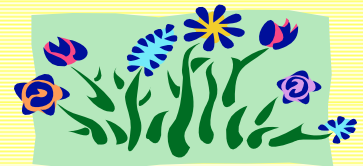

Class 1 Memorial Day

A 12" wreath staged on the back of a white oak chair

Class 2 Flag Day

Exhibition table setting staged on an oak table in a space 18" x 24" featuring red, white and blue.

Class 3 July 4th

A creative arrangement staged on a dining room table in a space 18" x 24"

Class 4 Twins Day

Arrangement in dual containers staged on a credenza in a space not to exceed 18" x 18"

Class 5 Vacation

A small design not to exceed 8" in any dimension.
Open to non-blue ribbon winners.

Class 6 Labor Day

Miniature design not to exceed 5" in any dimension staged in a lighted box.

General Rules

All members of Twinsburg Garden Club are invited and expected to exhibit.

An exhibitor is permitted to make one entry per class, but she may enter as many classes as she wishes.

Each design is to be the work of the exhibitor.

Entries will be received from 4pm – 6:15 pm on July 14th at the home of Marlene Hatton at 10386 North Pond Lane off Ethans Drive near Darrow Road. Meeting will start promptly at 6:30 pm.

Plants on the Conservation List are permitted for use in the show if grown by the exhibitor. Please include a note to that effect with your entry. Feathers and artificial materials are not permitted.

Exhibits may not be altered after judging.

In the event an exhibitor is unable to fulfill her commitment, she must secure her own replacement.

Design Division Rules

No artificial flowers, foliage, fruit or vegetables are permitted.

Some plant material must be used in every exhibit

Religious symbols must be displayed in a respectful manner and in accordance with policies of local religious organizations.

The official American Flag and other national flags are not permitted to be used within any design.

Furthermore, the use of any official national flag as an underlay, background, skirting, draping, etc. is prohibited.

Living members of the animal kingdom are not permitted in the Design Division.

The following are permitted unless prohibited by schedule or law.

Accessories, featured objects

Treating of dried plant material

Objects which add interest when tastefully used, e.g. nests, coral, sponges, sea fans, shells, bones, antlers, horns, or starfish.

Special lighting

Living plants with roots attached e.g. leek, bromeliad, moss

Scale of Points

Conformance (To schedule requirements)	20
Design (Elements, Principles)	42
Artistic Concept (Selection and organization)	10
Expression (Interpretation of class by exhibitor)	10
