Plastics → fleece clothing, carpet, plastic containers, book bags

Milk jugs → decking, picnic tables, planters, water bottles

Newspaper → newsprint, cereal boxes, box packaging, tissue cores

Glass → new bottles and jars, fiberglass insulation, art glass

Cans → new beverage cans, vehicle parts foil products

Tires → playground surface, landscape mulch, fuel, rubber mats

Garden Trivia

- ◆ The inside of a cucumber can be up to 20 degrees cooler than the air temperature on warm days.
- ◆ Water moves up a tree trunk at 150 feet per hour
- ◆ The bark of a sequoia tree is as fireproof as asbestos
- ◆ The total length of roots and root hairs of a single rye plant can be 7,000 miles long. The roots can grow 3 miles per day.
- ◆ One large shade tree can remove 26 pounds of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere annually. This equals 11,000 miles of car emissions. One acre of trees can remove 13 tons of particles and gasses annually.

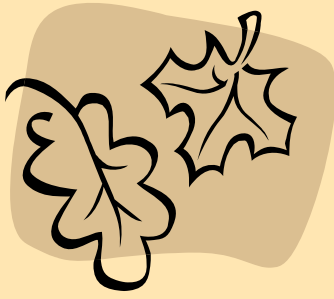

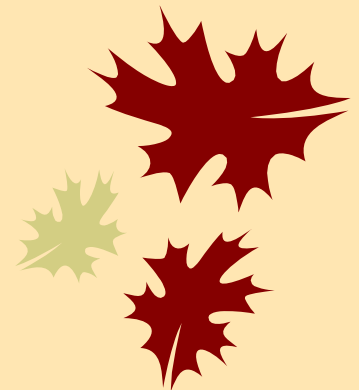


Twinsburg Garden Club Committees

- By-Laws** Reviews the bylaws every five years and makes necessary changes
- Civic Projects** Bring beauty to the City of Twinsburg
- Education** Work with schools and the community regarding garden projects
- Garden Tour** Select gardens for the tour and plan the event, including publicity
- Field Trips** Arrange two or three Field Trips per year
- Garden of the Week** Photograph gardens of note, submit to the Twinsburg Bulletin
- Historian** Collect newspaper articles pertaining to the Club as well as event photographs, assemble a scrapbook documenting the year's activities
- Holiday Party** Plan all aspects of the Holiday Party in December
- Holiday Swags** Make arrangements for greens and other supplies needed for swag making at November meeting
- Hostess Coordinator** Remind monthly Hostesses scheduled, maintain Hostess supplies at Senior Center as needed
- Newsletter** Produce monthly newsletter
