Jan, our auctioneer, with the items left from the garage sale and those donated from Wolfscape Landscaping helped to raise another \$150.00.

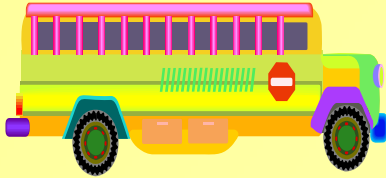
